DEFAULT ORDER

THIS MATTER came before the New Mexico Respiratory Care Advisory Board (“Board”) on August 29, 2014, and the Board finds as follows:

1. A Notice of Contemplated Action was issued on October 25, 2013, regarding a license application submitted by the Respondent to the Board and received by the Board on February 13, 2012.
2. The NCA alleged that Respondent, in his application, disclosed that his license to practice as a respiratory care practitioner in the State of Indiana had been suspended.
3. Respondent’s actions which resulted in the suspension of his Indiana license constitute unprofessional or unethical conduct and has failed to satisfy the Board of his qualifications to be issued a license by the Board.
4. The NCA was served on Respondent in accordance with the Uniform Licensing Act (“ULA”), NMSA 1978, Section 61-1-5 at Respondent’s last known address.
5. The NCA was delivered by the USPS on October 29, 2013, and signed by the Respondent.
6. Respondent did not request a hearing pursuant to the ULA.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 61-12B-12, the Board is hereby denying the application for a New Mexico respiratory care practitioner license submitted by the Respondent, Paul O. Kindig.

The order is final and not subject to judicial review.
