This Bulletin announces the Construction Industries Division's (CID) continuing education requirements for renewal of journeyman lineman electrician certificates of competence (EL-1J). The State Legislature enacted into law continuing education requirements which include at least sixteen (16) hours continuing education for each period between currently adopted National Electrical Safety Code updates. Of the required sixteen hours, eight (8) hours are code change instructions and eight (8) hours are other industry-related instruction.

The Division, with Construction Industries Commission approval adopted Continuing Education Rules at the July 10, 2009 Commission Meeting. The Continuing Education Rules and Course and Instructor Applications outline the criteria for approval of continuing education courses and instructors. The Continuing Education Requirement effective dates are as follows:

Effective **January 20, 2010** the Division and Electrical Bureau will begin accepting applications for continuing education course and instructor approvals.

Effective **January 1, 2011** proof of completion of the continuing education requirements shall be submitted to the Division with the application for renewal of journeyman lineman electrician certificate of competence. An application for renewal that is not accompanied by proof of completion of the continuing education requirements will be considered incomplete and will not be processed.
