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These CPT Codes reflect many of the procedures that doctors of oriental medicine in New Mexico are authorized to perform pursuant to The Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine Practice Act. The definition of the scope of practice for DOM's may be found in Section 61-14A-3 of that Act and Part 2 -Scope of Practice of the Rules of the New Mexico Board of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (16.2.2 NMAC). It should be noted that DOM's also perform other procedures that are not included in this list or identified by these CPT codes. Furthermore, not all DOM's are authorized to perform all procedures. If a DOM performs a procedure, he or she is required by the New Mexico Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine Practice Act to possess and apply the knowledge and use the skill and care used by reasonably well-qualified DOM's practicing under similar circumstances. Finally, Injection and IV procedures listed above may only be performed by a DOM who is certified for the Extended (Rx1) Prescriptive Authority or the Expanded (Rx2) Prescriptive Authority, as indicated by an "Rx1" or "Rx2" designation in their license number.
