Subject: Emergency Authorization for Dispensing of Anti-virals from In-patient Hospital Pharmacies and Public Health Clinics.

Pursuant to the terms of the “Emergency Dispensing Declaration” approved by the Board of Pharmacy on August 24, 2009, the following facilities may dispense anti-viral pharmaceuticals to persons not classified as patients of that facility:

Inpatient hospital pharmacies may receive and dispense the authorized antiviral medications to persons not classified as inpatients at the facility pursuant to the terms of the Emergency Use Authorizations (EUA) for Tamiflu and Relenza given by the FDA. This authorization also includes the in-house clinics operating within the licensed hospital and the emergency care departments.

Class B and Class C clinics licensed by the Board of Pharmacy may receive and distribute/dispense the anti-virals to persons who are not classified as patients of that facility as long as the EUAs are in effect.

This authorization remains in effect until further notice.
