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***PHARMACIST LICENSURE BY EXAM***

New Mexico Board of Pharmacy

To be eligible for the NAPLEX and MPJE you must have 1500 intern/extern hours for the Doctor of Pharmacy program that includes a maximum of 1500 hours through an academic extern program or, 1500 intern/extern hours for the Bachelor of Science programs that includes a maximum of 675 hours obtained through an academic extern program. You must supply the NM Board of Pharmacy with a certified letter from your college of pharmacy, or from the resident state board where you attended school, verifying your intern hours.

All transferring Interns must complete an Application for Registration (available by calling, or e mail [Sarah.Trujillo@state.nm.us](mailto:Sarah.Trujillo@state.nm.us) the New Mexico Board of Pharmacy) as Pharmacist by Examination. Please attach your school transcripts.

You are required to take both the NAPLEX and MPJE examinations. You may register online at [www.nabp.pharmacy](http://www.nabp.pharmacy) for both examinations. The process can take a few days or several weeks pending on if your application is complete. A passing score of 75 on each examination is required to be a licensed pharmacist in New Mexico.

You will be notified by mail regarding the results of your test within 3 to 5 days. If you have passed, an Application for Initial Licensure and Affidavit will be sent to you with the notification of a passing score. Complete the Pharmacist Application and Affidavit and return to the Board of Pharmacy with the appropriate fee. If you have failed you will be required to register with the NABP for the appropriate exam.
