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# New Mexico Physical Therapy Board PHYSICAL THERAPIST APPLICATION

Mail application, photograph, jurisprudence exam and fees to the address at the top of this application. You will receive written notification regarding the status of your application within 10-15 days of receipt.

#### **FEES**

- An application/jurisprudence fee of \$275 is required from each applicant.
- If the applicant *has NOT taken* the National Physical Therapy Examination (NPTE), an *additional* fee of \$25 is required.
- For a temporary license, an *additional* fee of \$35 is required.

#### REQUIRED SUBMISSIONS

- Completed application
- Fee in the form of a check or money order payable to the New Mexico Physical Therapy Board (NMPTB). *Application fees are non-refundable even if a license is not issued.*
- Passport-size photograph taken within one (1) year prior to filing the application.
- Documentation of graduation from an accredited educational program in the form of an official college or university transcript confirming the completion of the curriculum from a program approved by the Commission on Accreditation in Physical Therapy Education (CAPTE)
- Jurisprudence Examination

*Licensure by Endorsement* must meet all the requirements stated above and provide verification of all other licenses from other state jurisdictions. Verifications of licensure must be forwarded to this Board directly from other licensing jurisdictions.

### These verifications must provide:

- Name and address of applicant
- License number and date of issuance
- Current status of the license and expiration date of license
- A statement of whether the applicant was denied a license by the agency
- A statement of whether any disciplinary action is pending or has been taken against the applicant

*Credentialing Evaluation Reports* must be received directly from a board-approved credentialing agency. Foreign-educated applicants must meet all requirements in *16.20.9 NMAC*, *Education Criteria for Foreign-Educated Applicants*.

**Translations:** All documents not in English must be accompanied by a translation of the document that shall be attached to the document and shall bear the notarized affidavit of the translator certifying that he or she is competent in both the language of the document and the English language and that the translation is a true and complete translation of the foreign language original.

*National Physical Therapy Examination (NPTE)* scores shall be sent directly to the Board office from the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy (FSBPT).

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
