Public Comments and Complaints

The Regulation and Licensing Department Alcohol & Gaming Division works closely with the Special Investigations Division (SID) of the state Department of Public Safety to enforce the provisions of the Liquor Control Act. Violations of the Act by liquor license holders can result in fines and/or suspension of the license. Three violations within a 12-month period can result in revocation of a liquor license.

We welcome public comments, either positive or negative, regarding liquor license holders and their employees. Protecting the people of New Mexico from the often tragic effects of underage drinking, DWI and alcohol abuse requires the active support of all our citizens. Please help us by reporting when you observe a licensed liquor establishment or its employees violating state law or failing in their obligations to the community.

In filing a complaint, it is important that you provide us with as much information as possible, so that SID investigators will be able to pursue your complaint.
