

This is an amendment to 16.20.3 NMAC, Section 11, effective XX/XX/2017.

**16.20.3.11 [LICENSURE BY ENDORSEMENT:**

~~A. A license may be issued to a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant who provides verification of all licenses from other U.S. jurisdictions, and meets all the requirements in 16.20.3.8 NMAC. The board will accept verifications via regular mail, electronic mail, or facsimile. Verifications must be signed and dated by an official of the agency licensing the applicant and must include the following:~~

- ~~(1) name and address of the applicant;~~
- ~~(2) license number and date of issuance;~~
- ~~(3) current status of the license;~~
- ~~(4) expiration date of the license;~~
- ~~(5) national examination scores received directly from the reporting jurisdiction;~~
- ~~(6) a statement as to whether the applicant was denied a license by the agency;~~
- ~~(7) a statement as to whether any disciplinary action is pending or has been taken against the applicant.~~

~~B. A license may be issued to a foreign educated physical therapist who has a valid unrestricted license from another U.S. jurisdiction provided that the applicant meets all of the requirements in 16.20.3.8 NMAC and 16.20.9 NMAC.]~~ **LICENSURE BY RECIPROCIITY:**

A. The board shall issue a license by reciprocity to an applicant who holds a current license in good standing in another U.S. jurisdiction that meets or exceeds the licensing and qualification requirements set out in Section 61-12D-10 NMSA 1978, provided the applicant submits an application on a form approved by the board with the required fee as forth in Subsection F of Section 61-12D-10 NMSA1978 and 16.20.3.8 NMAC.

B. A foreign-educated physical therapist or physical therapist assistant who has a current license in good standing from another U.S. jurisdiction may be issued a license provided the applicant meets all of the requirements set forth in Subsection A and B of Section 61-12D-10 NMSA 1978 and Section A of 16.20.3.11 NMAC and 16.20.4.8 NMAC.
