
DEFAULT ORDER

THIS MATTER having come before the New Mexico Private Investigations Advisory Board on September 8, 2011 with a quorum present and a majority voting in the affirmative the Board finds as follows:

1. A Notice of Contemplated Action (NCA) was served upon Respondent on the 14th of April, 2011 in accordance with the Uniform Licensing Act (ULA); Section 61-1-1 to 61-1-33 NMSA 1978.
2. Respondent did not request a Hearing within twenty (20) days of receipt of service of the NCA as set forth in the ULA, in accord with Section 61-1-4 (B)(3) NMSA 1978.
3. Pursuant to the provisions of the ULA, if the Respondent does not request a hearing, the Board may proceed to take action against the license of the Respondent by default, in accord with Section 61-1-4(E) NMSA 1978.
4. As such, the Board unanimously voted in open session to revoke the license of the Respondent.
