

New Mexico Real Estate Commission Seeking Applicants for Appointment to the Education Advisory Committee

The New Mexico Real Estate Commission (Commission) is seeking applicants from among licensed Real Estate Brokers and Qualifying Brokers for a vacant position within the Education Advisory Committee (Committee).

The Committee's goal is to upgrade and improve "...the real estate education program in order to carry out the commission's mission of protecting the public and increasing the professional competence of real estate brokers. The committee shall advise the commission on all matters related to broker education."

The committee meets monthly or as required for the purpose of evaluating applications for real estate course sponsors, courses, and instructors and shall make recommendations to the commission as to its findings. The committee also meets to develop long term plans for the course of real estate education in New Mexico for recommendation to the Commission.

The committee consists of up to nine voting members and no fewer than three non-voting instructor/advisory members. The Term of this appointment as a voting member will be a 2 year term.
