**DEFAULT ORDER**

**THIS MATTER** having come before the State of New Mexico Private Investigators Advisory Board ("Board") and with a quorum present and a majority voting in the affirmative the Board finds as follows:

1. A Notice of Contemplated Action ("NCA") was served upon Respondent on March 21, 2015 in accordance with the Uniform Licensing Act ("ULA"), NMSA 1978, Section 61-1-1 to -33;
2. The NCA was received by Respondent on March 21, 2015 as indicated by the date of delivery on the U.S. Postal Service Certified Mail Receipt;
3. Respondent failed to request a hearing within twenty days of receipt of the NCA pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 61-1-4;
4. Pursuant to the provisions of the ULA, if Respondent does not request a hearing, the Board may proceed to take action by default;
5. It is therefore ordered and adjudged that Respondent did fail to respond to a properly served NCA in case No. PI- 01-2014-APP and is therefore found to be in default.
6. Respondent David Diaz's Application for a PI License is hereby denied.
